SCHOOL AND DIVISION IMPROVEMENT ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

Prairie

Derrick Huschi, on behalf of all Superintendents of School Operations, presented the School & Division Improvement Accountability Report to the Board. Learning Improvement Plans (LIPs) ensure schools are responsive to the needs of students and they vary between schools based on local context. Our schools are provided LIP templates for consistent data to look at data year over year with the same cohort of students. About half of our schools reported they didn't achieve their goals, and we have determined that is because they have set their goals too high. We are working on making the goals more attainable from year to year with our schools. In 2023-24 we held three School Community Council (SCC) Engagement Sessions in Rouleau, Gravelbourg, and Moose Jaw. All SCCs were invited to attend the sessions where innovative ideas were shared, and those ideas were then shared out to all SCCs. Prairie South SCCs created a Facebook page which has over 135 followers.

BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL AND SPECIAL BOARD MEETING DATE

The new Board of Education will be elected on November 13, 2024 and our Audited Financial Statements and Annual Report need to be approved by November 29, 2024. This current Board needs to set the date for the first meeting of the new Board, where they will set all future meeting dates for the year as well as nominate a Chair and Vice-Chair for the Board. The date will be Tuesday, November 26, 2024. Following the Organizational Meeting, they will hold a Special Meeting to review the AFS and Annual Report.
