NEW RATES

The Board approved an increase to the mileage rate and meal allowance, effective December 1 and for the remainder of the 2024-25 fiscal year. The new rates are as follows:

> Mileage = \$0.53/km Breakfast = \$16 Lunch = \$23 Supper = \$31

ANNUAL REPORT AND AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The 2023-2024 Annual Report was presented to the Board. This Report is tabled in the Saskatchewan Legislature annually and includes information on our School Community Councils, the Board's Strategic Plan, targets and measures from the Provincial Education Plan, infrastructure projects, and transportation information. Also included with the Annual Report is the Audited Financial Statements. The 2023-2024 Statements have been audited by our external auditor, MNP LLP and were found to present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the school division as at August 31, 2024.

The Board approved the Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements for the period ending August 31, 2024, pending possible format revisions following final review by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Finance. The 2023-2024 fiscal year resulted in revenue of \$109,267,435 and operating expenses of \$98,919,941 for a net surplus of \$10,347,494. It's important to note that there was 12.5 million capital funding for the new Coteau Hills School included in revenue.
