TRANSPORTATION ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT HIGHLIGHTS



Our Transportation Manager, Todd Johnson presented the Accountability Report for the 2023–24 school year. During the year, we provided daily transportation services to over 2840 students, travelled over 18,200 kilometers and efficiently ran 106 bus routes. Our mechanics team consisted of 6 mechanics and 2 mechanics helpers with over 200 years of combined experience. They worked closely together sharing ideas and finding solutions using innovative problem-solving skills to correct recurring issues. Our bus fleet consisted of 146 units including 9 wheelchair accessible buses. We employed 150 bus drivers who provided regular daily transportation and also provided 1798 charter trips throughout the year. We continued our First Rider Program in Moose Jaw and Assiniboia. This program provides first-time riders and their families an opportunity to learn about bus safety and gives them a chance to ride the bus for the first time. In August of 2024, there were 73 students who participated, and we are looking at expanding the program in our rural schools in future years. A big thank you to the office staff, mechanics, and bus drivers for your support and for safely transporting students to and from school each and every day.
